Who is eligible to attend?

Middle School Camp is for students who have completed 6th through 8th grade.
High School Camp is for students who have completed 9th through 12th grade.

What is the cost?

PLEASE NOTE: NO WALK UP REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED

Due to construction on dorms, we aren't accepting registrations after May 31st except in extreme situations. This should help make registration more streamlined for everyone. If you have questions or concerns, please contact your camp director or registration team (listed below) in advance.

How to register?

Please first register online at <https://form.jotform.com/midsouthnyi/camp-registration-2024>.

- **Students** are to then print the Medical Release and Zipline form. These forms require a parent/guardian signature. In the case of the Medical Release, notarization is also needed. Both need to be completed and originals need to be turned in to their local Youth Pastor or Leader.
 - **If you don't have originals on hand when you arrive at camp, you will not be allowed to stay.**
- **Sponsors** need to additionally have a background check and Naz Safe Certified from their local church.

What time does camp start and end?

Registration is:

- 2-4 PM on Monday, June 3rd for High School Camp. HS Camp concludes at 11AM on Friday, June 7th.
- 2-4 PM on Monday, June 10th for Middle School Camp. MS Camp concludes at 11AM on Friday, June 14th.
**Registration should be simplified and expedited this year. All rooming information and account balances will be sent out to churches in the week after registration closes.*

Refund/Transfer Policy:

In the event that a student cannot attend camp after submitting their registration, that student may transfer their payment to another student, **who has not registered for camp**. That student and/or church must find a replacement/transfer as well as notify the registrar of that change before arriving at camp. No refunds will be given.

There are lots of do's and don'ts on this page...but our greatest expectation is that you would come to camp with a heart and mind that is ready to receive what God has for you this week. We see Garner Creek as Holy Ground...where God is pursuing everyone with a desire for students to be open to respond to Him. Let this week be one full of expectation for what He can do.

Damages/Liability:

In an effort to maintain the quality and character of Garner Creek Retreat Center, any damages resulting in a cost, will be billed to the perpetrator(s) responsible. If the perpetrator cannot pay the local church, with whom they registered with, will assume responsibility for payment.

Leave the following items at Home:

- Alcohol or tobacco products
- Illegal drugs
- Explosives, including fireworks
- Paintball & airsoft guns
- Knives and firearms
- Shaving cream that will be used for anything other than shaving.
- Water balloons
- Pets
- Anything else that may get you in trouble

Things that will get you sent home early:

- Sneaking out after curfew
- Having a member of the opposite sex in your room
- Using immoral conduct, including vulgarity or profanity
- Fighting
- Failure to be at scheduled events/activities
- Destructive Pranks
- Actions deemed inappropriate by camp Staff

Things you agree to when you register:

- To adhere to the schedule of activities (The activities planned are NOT optional; you must attend all activities and be on time.)
- To adhere to the predetermined camp boundaries set by the Camp Director and Staff.
- To respect ALL Camp Counselors & Staff (not just the ones from your church)
- To turn in your car keys to the Camp Director if you drive your own vehicle.

Visitor Policy:

- Non-paid student visitors will not be allowed on camp property at any time.
- Adult visitors must check-in, be approved by the camp director, and be escorted by an approved member of the NYI Council.

Please remember:

We are guests of Garner Creek Retreat Center. Pranks will not be tolerated in or nearby cabins or any other camp building. If you sneak out of your room, you will be sent home at your parent's expense, even if it's the last night.

Dress Code:

Garner Creek Retreat Center is a Christian camp with a distinctly Christian atmosphere; modesty should always be the standard for dress. It is the responsibility of the sponsors from each church to model the standard of modesty & enforce the camp dress code.

The intent of the dress code is to provide an equitable dress code for all campers that will encourage modesty above legalism. Parents and church leaders are urged to see that only clothing that meets these policies and regulations be brought to camp. **If a camper violates the dress code, they will be asked to change into clothing that falls within the dress code**

General Appropriateness:

Apparel may not display or promote alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.

Swimming:

Modest swimming suits are appropriate while swimming. A dark t-shirt must be worn over two-piece swimming suits. While going to and from the swimming areas, all campers must wear shoes; males must wear a t-shirt and females must wear a long covering over their swimsuits.

Vehicles, ATV, and Golf Cart Usage:

No vehicles, ATVs, or golf carts are permitted to drive on the campground during camp unless they are approved by the Executive Camp Committee.

- No campers/students can ride on vehicles around the campground except in previously approved circumstances or in case of emergency. A shuttle will be running across camp ground during afternoon free time but that is the only vehicle that students/campers are permitted on regularly.

AGREEMENT TO CAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS
