



Camp Expectations:

Leave the Following Items at Home:

- Tobacco products
- Alcoholic drinks
- Illegal drugs
- Explosives, including fireworks
- Paintball & air-soft guns
- Shaving cream that will be used for anything other than shaving
- Water balloons
- Pets
- And anything else that may get you in trouble

Things to Bring:

- Towels
- Sleeping bag and/or bed linens
- Pillow
- Soap
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Bible/Pen/Journal
- Modest Swimsuit
- Athletic wear

Things That Will Get You Sent Home Early:

- Sneaking out after curfew
- Having a member of the opposite sex in your room
- Using immoral conduct including vulgarity or profanity
- Fighting
- Failure to be at scheduled activities and/or events
- Destructive pranks
- A number of others things

Things You Agree To When You Register:

- To adhere to the schedule of activities (The activities that are planned are NOT optional; you must attend all activities and be on time.)
- To adhere to the pre-determined camp boundaries set by the Camp Directors & staff
- To respect ALL camp counselors & staff (not just the ones from your church)
- To turn in your car keys to the Camp Director if you drive your own vehicle

Visitor Policy:

- Non-paid student visitors will not be allowed on camp property at any time
- Non registered adults should not attend camp. Any necessary exceptions must check-in and be approved by NYI leadership.

Please Remember:

- We are guests of Camp Garner Creek. Pranks will not be tolerated in or nearby cabins or any other camp buildings.
- If you sneak out of your room, you will be sent home at your parent's expense, even if it is Thursday night!

Dress Code:

- Bikinis are not permitted
- Halter tops are not permitted
- Spaghetti straps and/or shoulder straps should be two (2) fingers in width
- Shorts & skirts should be fingertip length (including the split)
- Strapless anything is not permitted
- Ultra low-rise is not permitted
- Dress modestly
- Tank tops for males are not permitted during worship services
- Dress modestly at all times

If a camper violates the dress code, that camper will be asked to change into clothing that falls within the Code.
