Thank you for serving as a leader for one of our VBS crews.

What does a Crew Leader do?

- Guide your crew through the schedule, transitioning between sites in a safe and orderly fashion.
- Be friendly and encouraging. Love on the kids and show them lots of smiles!
- Engage with the kids.
- Remind and example VBS Expectations for fun and safety (see below).
- Demonstrate grace, patience, and consistency.
- Pray with and for your crew.

VBS Expectations for Fun & Safety

- Follow directions.
- Stay with your crew and leader.
- Be kind and respectful.

What can I expect to happen during VBS?

- Kids will be assigned to crews through registration. Take attendance for your crew on the sheet that will be provided.
- o After supper, gather for the Opening (sanctuary). Crew Leaders should sit with their crews (look for the sign with your Crew #).
- Rotate through VBS sites per the schedule. Leaders at each site will instruct your crew how to participate in the activities there. Assist your crew as needed.
- o Gather for the Closing (sanctuary). Sit with your crew.
- Help kids with check-out as needed.

Other things...

- Manage bathroom breaks as necessary between site rotations.
- First Aid located in the fellowship hall, on the wall above the trash station.
